## Synopsis

Removes all plotting objects and creates a new blank drawing area.

## Syntax

```
chips> CLEAR
```

## Description

The newly-created drawing area is given the number designation 1.

## Example

```
chips> CLEAR
```

This command clears the plotting window and restores the drawing area number designation to 1.
