Synopsis

Return the photon wavelength corresponding to a given grating dispersion (GAC) value.

Syntax

```
Double_Type pix_get_grating_wavelength( Double_Type x, Double_Type y )
```

Description

Calculates the wavelength, in Angstrom, for a given grating position and using the current pixlib settings. The x and y values are in the GAC coordinate system, and so represent the grating dispersion and cross-dispersion angles in degrees. The grating order – as set by `pix_set_grating()` – must be non-zero for this routine to work.

The `pix_get_energy()` routine can be used to find the energy of the photon instead of the wavelength.
