## **SIM: Science Instrument Module**

The <u>ACIS</u> and <u>HRC</u> focal plane instruments are both attached to a single sliding stage, the Science Instrument Module (SIM). The SIM slides in the spacecraft Z-axis to move one of the flight instruments into the mirror (<u>HRMA</u>) focus, and has a focus adjustment in the spacecraft X-axis. The SIM also carries the fiducial lights use in the <u>aspect</u> system.
