Yaw

Yaw refers to motion in the y-direction of the telescope. In the case of the nominal <u>dither</u> period, the yaw is 1000 s for ACIS and 1087 s for HRC. <u>Table 5.3</u> in <u>the POG</u> gives the other default dither parameters in terms of <u>pitch</u> and yaw.
